The Annuary of Clinical and Health Psychology was born at the Department of Personality and Psychological Assessment and Treatment of Sevilla with the purpose of spreading research works from different points of view or schools related to our field of knowledge, giving the greatest importance to the nature of application of such contributions. This initiative counts with the participation of professors from various university centres of our country, who are part of the Editorial Committee of the journal.

Its design is simple: it is a publication only in electronic version, in Spanish and English, and its access is completely free not only for professionals but also for students. The presentation of this publication will be made in university centres and professional colleges trying to provide readers with valuable and updated information on a variety of subjects related to Clinical and Health Psychology. Despite its open nature, the journal does not pretend to be a source of disclosure for the general audience, but a place for specialized consultation mainly for professionals and students of our subject.

Each issue will develop two articles on a specific subject that will be requested by the direction of the journal to renown professionals specialized in the chosen content. Therefore, this section in the first issue will deal with the phenomenon of terrorism and psychopathology. Likewise, an article containing outstanding bibliography on the subject will be prepared. We think this design for the approach of a subject may be of great interest for professionals or students that are approaching a specific field of study for the first time.

The journal, that will be available the last month of each year, will offer different sections, besides the specific subject mentioned above: priority will be given to empirical investigations, articles specifically centred on the analysis of clinical cases as well as analyses of theoretical nature making practical contributions and suggestions. Works are reviewed by anonymous university professors who are part of the Editorial Committee and who, as specialists in the submitted contents, contribute to enhancing the quality of manuscripts accepted for publication by the journal.

We want to contribute, although in a modest way, to the spreading of knowledge related to our profession, taking advantage of the new technologies. We hope our project is of your interest, and we would like to invite you to be part of the same. Finally, we would like your centre to give the greatest possible disclosure to this information.
