## Internationalization in Central Asia and Eastern Neighbouring Area – ICAEN

### Aim of the Project:

ICAEN aims at building up the capacities of the partner country HEIs for international cooperation by upgrading Offices of International Relations, showing the benefits of internationalization for Teaching, Learning and Research.

### Specific objectives of the project:

- Benchmarking and identification of potentials and development of national recommendations for internationalization of teaching, learning and research in 3 partner countries of the Eastern Neighbouring Area and Central Asia;
- Enhancement of structural and human capacities for the development and implementation of policies and structures for international relations in 6 universities in Belarus, Georgia and Tajikistan by 2014;
- Development of a multi-regional network for a structured dialogue on internationalization and promotion of multi-lateral cooperation in Higher Education in Belarus, Georgia and Tajikistan by October 2014;
- Enhancement networking among higher education institutions and research institutions across the Partner Countries and EU Member States;
- Development of International relations.

## Internationalization in Central Asia and Eastern Neighbouring Area – ICAEN

### Main Activities and Results Obtained:

1. Strategic Plan of Internationalization in BTEU was developed. Experience of its development was disseminated among partner universities;
2. Structure of IRD was optimized;
3. Equipment and software were purchased to the amount of 29 492 EUR;
4. In consequence of held international seminars and trainings, assistants of IRD of BTEU have studied work experience of foreign partner universities in the field of internationalization;
5. With the aim of activization of participation in University's international activity and development of contacts network in the frames of research activities with foreign universities, Naumchik S., international activities manager, associate professor of Finance and Credit Chair, took part in intensive course of English language study in Heriott Watt University (Edinburgh, Scotland) and Haute Ecole Charlemagne (Liege, Belgium);
6. Assistants of BTEU IRD took part in international seminars and trainings with the aim of studying the advanced experience of partner Universities from Spain, Belgium, Holland, Tajikistan and Georgia;
7. As the result of studying the work of IRD of Partner Universities, electronic bases of foreign students' registration and international cooperation agreements were developed.
